

Determine which entrance to your home has the easiest access for placement in your home. Below are some things you need to consider measuring before your product is delivered.

Any Doorways (including entrances and any internal doorways)




- Measure the height, width and diagonal height of your doorway (width may be reduced if you cannot fully open your door). If the fit is going to be tight it may make more sense to remove the door.
- Check for any architectural details that may impede access (e.g. crown moulding)

Hallways




- As with doorways you should measure the height, width and depth of all hallways.
- Also measure diagonally to ensure there will be enough room to tilt or rotate the item, if needed

Stairways



- Measure the width of your stairway, taking into account any handrails or posts
- Measure the height from the top and bottom steps to the ceiling
- Make sure the item can fit on and around landings

Elevators



- Measure the height width and diagonal height of the elevator door opening
- Measure the interior depth and interior width of the elevator
- Also measure the diagonal depth of the elevator
- Also account for any handrails or lights within the elevator as they cannot be removed
