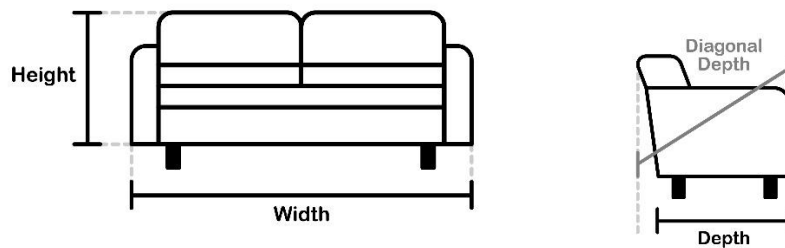

## Sofa or Chair







There are four main measurements sizing sofa or chair

- Overall height of sofa or chair. Keep in mind that you may have to include the feet as some don't unscrew. Also with some sofas and chairs the backs can be easily removed and replaced.
- Overall width – arm to arm.
- Depth and diagonal depth (again diagonal depth may have to include feet as some don't unscrew).



## Mattresses

Below is a chart listing the dimensions of the various mattress sizes.

## **Appliances**

Appliances come in all shapes and sizes but typically you will find a specification sheet on our website where you will find the dimensions of your product. If one is not available ask your sales associate and they will provide you with one. Below are some things to keep in mind when ordering your appliance (this is not an exhaustive list).

- Make sure that your appliance will fit into any existing cabinetry (including e.g. if you want the unit to sit flush with your cabinet make sure your doors will still open)
- If you have an island in your kitchen is there sufficient space for your appliance to be wheeled around it (it is extremely difficult to lift most appliance over an island).
