

# Seasonal Maintenance Program

### Introduction

A Yale Appliance service technician will perform a Seasonal Maintenance check to keep your appliances in peak condition during periods of inactivity. This check will include testing all basic operations, filter replacements (sold separately), and cleanings. Should the technician find any defects, malfunctions, or parts that need to be ordered, the service technician will quote all parts and additional labor cost per appliance on site.

## **Explanation of program**

Service	Purpose
Installation	Checking for correct voltage
	Ensuring the appliance is hooked up to the correct water supply and connections are intact and free from leaks. Check to see water temp is correct and there is adequate drainage
Temperature	The technician will verify and calibrate the temperature of the cooking and cooling products
Ventilation	The technician will make sure ventilation is adequate and free from obstruction
Security	The technician will make sure the appliance is properly secured to a wall or cabinet and check on the anti-tip device if applicable
Basic Operation	The technician will test basic operation on all components related to the appliance.
Filter Replacement	The Yale Appliance technician will replace all water and air filters (filters sold separately)

#### Parts Needed?

The technician will give a detailed description and quote any parts and/or labor needed. The pricing comes from the New England Flat Rate Repair Guide. The technician will schedule a service call return trip before leaving the residence.



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
